

Survivor Sunday's Official Rules & Regulations 2023 Season



- 1. All participants must be of legal age in the Province, State or Country of residence. Participants from Ontario must be 18 years of age or older
- 2. The official results, as posted by AGCO Judges shall constitute the official results for this contest.
- 3. The entrant will endeavour to select a horse who will finish in the top three in all the scheduled races on the weeks card. The entrant will select their choice, with an alternative for each race. If the original selection is scratched, the alternate will be deemed the new selection for the entrant. If, by chance, both selections are scratched, the entrant will receive the post time favorite. No alternative selection will be allowed if your initial selection is refunded for any reason.
- 4. In the event of a dead heat, all horses involved shall be deemed to be official winners for the purpose of this contest and moving on to the next round.
- 5. Entrants selection must finish in the top three to move on to the next race. If entrant's selection does not finish in the top three, they are eliminated from the weeks contest.
- 6. To be eligible for the HPIbet cash deposit, you must have an active account set up prior to entering the contest. All winners that are non-account holders will receive a secondary prize at the discretion of Clinton Raceway Inc. In the event that the winner (s) are not a resident of an HPIBet market, or the winner does not want to sign up for and account, an acceptable prize package will be mailed to the address provided by the entrant.
- 7. Entrant with the most consecutive top three finishers will be deemed to have won the Survivor Sunday Challenge. The winner shall receive the sum of \$100 (one hundred) Canadian Dollars deposited into their HPIBet account. In the event of a tie with five or fewer winners the prize shall be split equally among the winners. If six or more winners tie, all winners' names will be entered into a random draw and five names will be selected. The five names selected will be considered the winners of that week's contest and will split the \$100 prize equally.
- 8. The contest will run through consecutive races until all contestants are eliminated, or the final races has been conducted, whichever comes first.
- 9. All staff of Clinton Raceway Inc or the AGCO are not eligible to participated.
- 10. All entries must be received before the official post time for the first race of each race card during the contest period.
- 11. Only one entry, per person, per race day.
- 12. Entries can be made completed and submitted via www.clintonraceway.com

- 13. Contest winners agree to having their name and image (if applicable) used by Clinton Raceway Inc in any aspect related to the Survivor Sunday Contest.
- 14. Incomplete entries or entries completed incorrectly (using horse name rather than number, etc) will be considered null and void.
